I will provide you with essentially the same response I provided to the Irish Rover:

The Responsible Use Policy states that the use of University information technology resources, like the use of any other University-provided resource and like any other University-related activity, is subject to the requirements of legal and ethical behavior within this community. Posting, viewing or sending obscene, pornographic, offensive or sexually explicit material is not consistent with the ideals expressed in the University's mission statement. When brought to our attention, we reserve the right to investigate any claim of inappropriate use of technology resources by a student or employee, and when we find a violation we can and will assess an appropriate sanction, which can come in various forms, including suspension of that individual's NetID, and up to expulsion or termination of employment. The University relies on the integrity of our students, faculty and staff to abide by this and many other policies.
